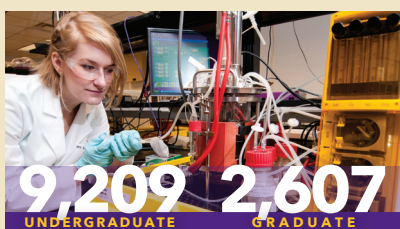

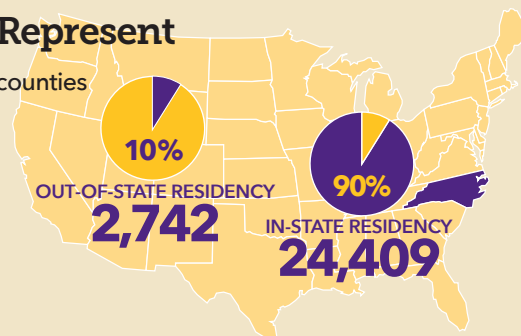

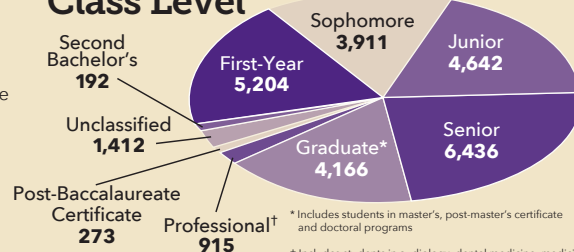

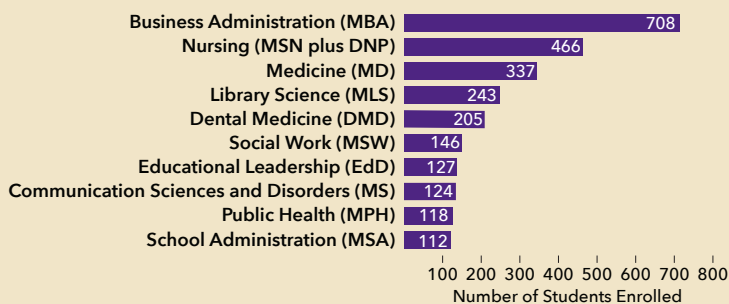


Highest-Enrollment Degree Programs
